Members will be asked to approve this Plan that describes the focus of KEIFCA's research over the next 5 years.

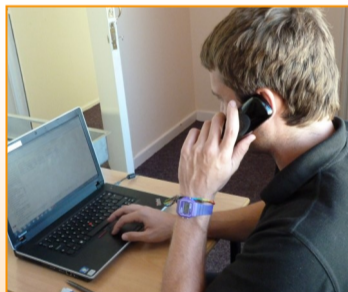
